

Alcohol Ordinance: Happy Hours, Alcohol Promotions, Giveaways and Tastings in Illinois

Municipality, County, & Population	Ordinance Language & Ordinance Link
Loves Park, IL Boone and Winnebago Counties Population: 23,996	Section 6-54 Happy hours permitted. General language allowing for happy hours in licensed establishments in accordance with the provisions and prohibitions of the Illinois Liquor Control Act.
Gurnee, IL Lake County Population: 31,295	Section 6-20 Happy hours prohibited. Language included on prohibited happy hour promotions. Includes prohibited sales practices as well as allowances for meal packages, hotel packages, room service, and other allowable services. Violations are addressed.
Villa Park, IL DuPage County Population: 21,800	Section 3-416 Prohibited and permitted happy hours language. Definitions of dedicated event space, meal package, and party package included.
DuPage County, IL Population: 916,924	Section 3-48 Prohibition of liquor promotions. Language included to prohibit happy hours, double drinks, two for ones, all you can drink specials, lady's night, men's night, and games and contests.

Park Ridge, IL Cook County Population: 37,480	Section 12-6-27 Definitions General definition of happy hour is provided.
Highland Park Lake County Population: 29,763	Section 119.560 Giveaways and tastings. Language specifying alcoholic liquor tasting event conditions and limitations. Unlawful to give away or dispense alcohol free of charge with the intent of promoting the sale of that alcoholic beverage.
Buffalo Grove, IL Lake and Cook Counties Population: 41,496	Section 5.20.075 Alcohol beverage tasting. Language included on monthly and yearly tasting requirements. Conditions and limitations for tastings are outlined.
