Peer to Peer Teen Safe Driving Program Guidelines

Establish a teen group within your school to plan and implement safe driving activities.

Program activities must be planned and led by teens and monitored by an adult.

Conduct Pre and Post seat belt surveys (Submit by April 15, 2022)

Use of social media

Community outreach

Provide traffic safety education to elementary students.

Submit photos and program information as they are completed so they can be shared through the Traffic Safety Resource Center.

Create a safe driving PSA (optional) (Submit by April 15, 2022)

You may begin your program activities at any time, program ends April 15, 2022.

Pre seat belt surveys are to be complete before program activities begin, post seat belt surveys are to be completed after all program activities are completed and by April 15, 2022.

Activity ideas and resources will be provided to participating schools.
