What is Naloxone?

- Naloxone is an antidote to an opioid overdose.
- Opioid overdose is when there is more drug, like heroin, in your body than it can handle.
- Naloxone is not a controlled substance and cannot be abused.

Naloxone is available without a prescription from participating pharmacies and through grant funded programs.
