

# CANNABIS STASH BAG GIVEAWAY PILOT INITIATIVE

## **Campaign Overview**

Let's Talk Cannabis IL is a public health campaign developed by the Illinois Department of Human Services and Prevention First. The campaign seeks to educate the public about the health considerations and responsible use of non-medical cannabis. Through educational content, the campaign provides trustworthy and unbiased legal and health information to help the public make informed decisions.

### **Material Overview**

These 11" W x 6" H canvas stash bags are intended to help parents and guardians keep cannabis products safely stored and out of the hands of young children. They are lockable, water-resistant, and smell-proof. The front side features the Let's Talk Cannabis logo and website URL. The back side features a QR code linked to the Let's Talk Cannabis Parent & Mentor page. We will also provide locking instructions and this educational handout that highlights the risks of using cannabis as a new or expecting mom and the importance of safe storage.

#### Shipping

Prevention First will ship 400 bags among 4 boxes (*while supplies last*) to interested partners. Each box weighs approximately 33 lbs. We will also provide signage to promote the bags. An email notice will be sent once materials have shipped.

#### Distribution

Please distribute these bags to parents or guardians of young children who may have cannabis at home. You *do not* need to collect any information from bag recipients.

#### Communication

Prevention First will check in and send a follow-up survey within six months of initial distribution.
